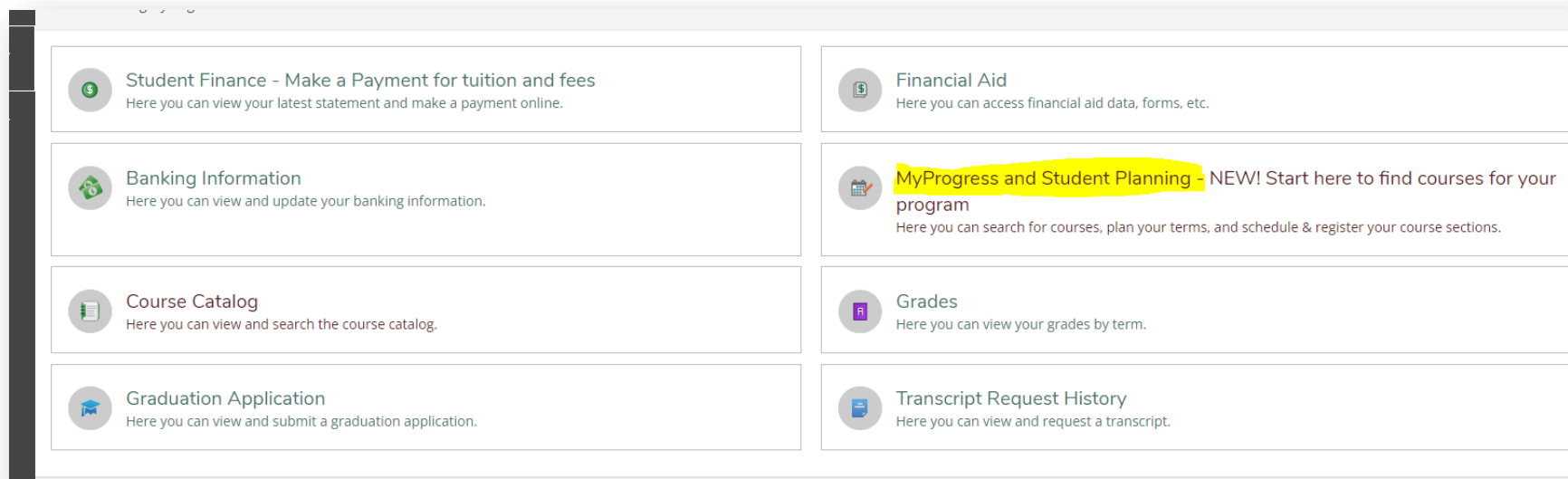


Take the MyProgress Pre-Launch Tour

MyProgress is an interactive degree planning tool that the University **will launch during the July 2023 term**. It will allow you to easily identify appropriate TESU credit-earning options for your degree program and preplan your degree requirements. MyProgress will replace the University's traditional Academic Evaluation and will be accessed in myEdison® Student Self-Service. Before TESU officially launches MyProgress, we wanted to provide you with a visual tour of the environment:

1. Once logged in to myEdison®, you will select the **MyProgress and Student Planning** tile on the home page (or) from the dropdown. Note: You will notice that we've reconfigured the tiles so that they now incorporate MyProgress as a starting point for selecting your courses.

- The first section will display an At-a-Glance *Program Summary* for the degree program you are reviewing. You can switch between degree programs on your record by using the arrows in the summary. The *Program Summary* shows the number of credits you must complete toward your degree and those you have already completed. If you have taken TESU courses for graded credit, your GPA will also be listed in this section.

3. Below the *Program Summary*, you will see your degree program *Description* and *Program Notes* sections. You will be able to check both places for the enrollment and program information and alerts.

Description

The Bachelor of Science degree program in Aviation Maintenance Technology is limited to FAA licensed airframe and power plant mechanics. Equivalent military training may be considered. The BS degree in Aviation Maintenance is a 120-credit program.

Many students in the following degree programs; Associate of Applied Science with an option in Aviation Support, Associate & Bachelor of Science with an area of study in Air Traffic Control, Aviation Flight Technology and Aviation Management use credits earned from professional licenses and/or certifications which have been evaluated by a Thomas Edison State University Prior Learning Review. The PLR credits awarded will fulfill some or all of the courses in the area of study in this degree program. In addition, our Thomas Edison State University Academic Advising team is prepared to assist you in identifying ways to earn any remaining area of study requirements which cannot be completed at Thomas Edison State University. If you do not have the appropriate license or certification or wish to pursue a degree where you can earn all your credits at Thomas Edison State University, please consider one of our degrees available as noted on our online degree webpage.

ENC-101 Writing for Success (3 Credits) [Add Course to Plan](#)

Effective writing is one of the skills most often cited by employers as essential to their employees' success. In this introductory course, students develop skills critical for both academic and career success through writing material that is intended to inform by providing unbiased facts. Students are guided through activities that help them understand the writing process, develop the ability to succinctly state and support their thesis statements and point of view, identify and incorporate information from outside sources, and customize their writing for specific target audiences. Students share their progress throughout the term in short essays and workshop discussions. The course culminates with the opportunity to identify a problem affecting the student's life, attempting to solve it through careful research and logical argumentation, and communicating the findings verbally and in writing.

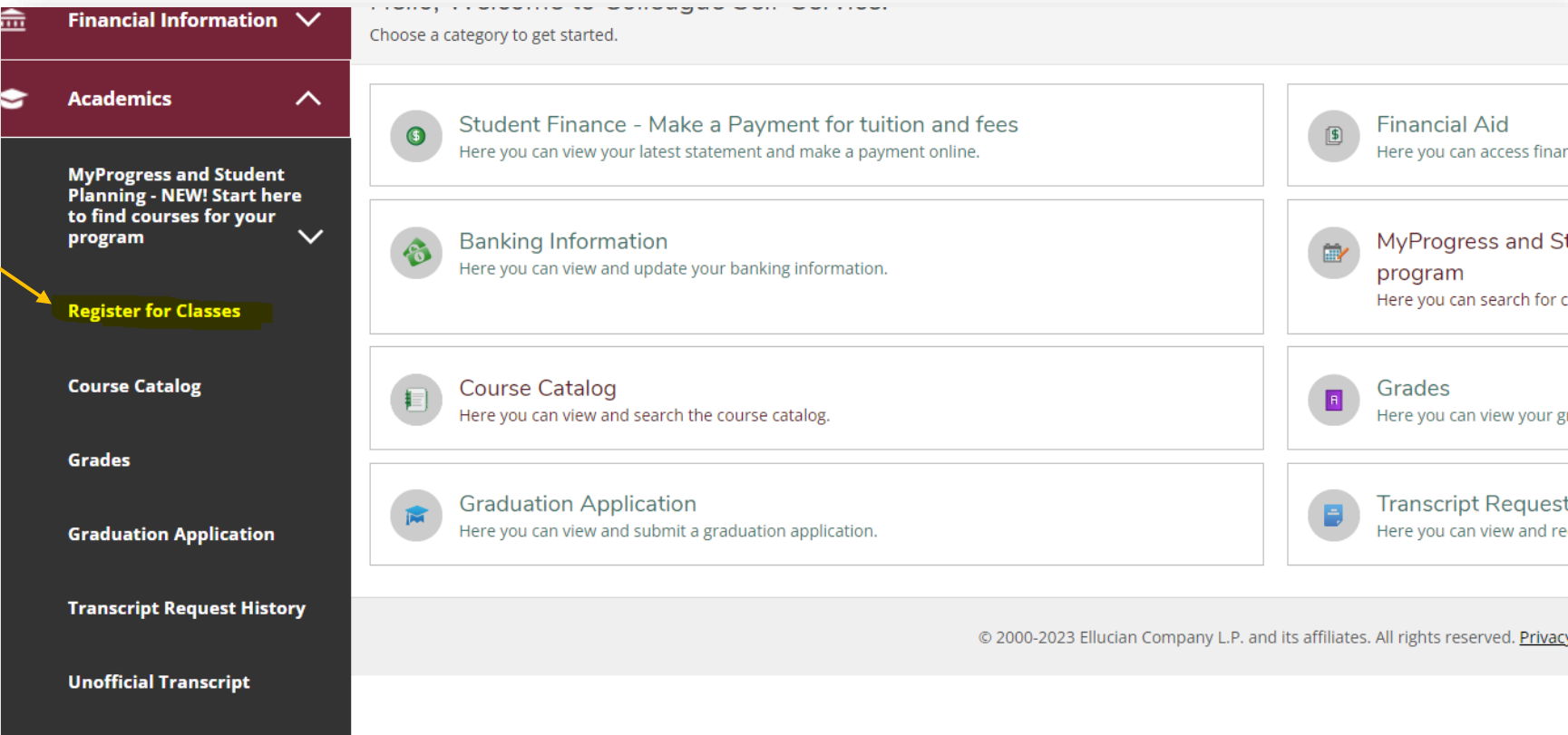

- From the list of possible exams and courses, students can filter by various course catalog criteria, such as academic level, term offered, mentor information, etc. and are able to view advisory information about each course.
- Once you select the exam or course you want, click **Add Course to Plan** to plan the course in a future term. You can plan as many exams/courses or as few as you want into the future. As you plan them, you will see them populate in MyProgress.
- *Request a Review* of your planned courses by the Office of Academic Advising to confirm you have selected the correct courses for your degree.
- Once registration for that term starts, go into your planned courses for that term and select the specific section you want, such as OL/GS/EP/TE or by mentor, etc., and register.

5. Continue this process in the *MyProgress* and *Student Planning* section until you have identified and selected your courses. Once you are ready to register, click the *Academics* dropdown on the left indicated by the graduation cap icon and select *Register for Classes*.

8. **Important:** You will need to pay close attention to the number of courses and credits required for each degree requirement in MyProgress. If we offer multiple courses that could be used to fill a specific degree requirement, you may see them *all* listed as options, but you only need to select the number required for your specific program. In the example below, the requirement is **one** course for 3 credits even though we offer the other three courses as options. Once you complete the required course you need, the rest are marked as **Fulfilled** automatically.
